OMC-140 Multifunctional TFT Display (sw-version 2.4 & >)

Wherever you need to visualise your critical measurement information on a dedicated instrument, the OMC-140 can be used. Whether it concerns presenting wind information (wind speed and direction, gust and variation, true or relative) or an indication of other meteorological parameters (temperature, humidity, barometric pressure, visibility and cloud base), the OMC-140 is the ideal instrument. Because of its multifunctional character, the unit is also suitable for other purposes, such as GPS and Gyro, speed log indicator, echo sounder display, etc. On an 8.5" (long-life, low powered) LED backlight, industrial grade, LCD screen your data will be indicated with a true viewing angle of 170°.

General

In 2015, Observator supplied her first OMC-140 Multifunctional TFT displays, as the successor of the popular LED display line OMC-13X/93X. At the time of release, the OMC-140 was provided with firmware for basic displays of meteo data and some other non-meteorological parameters. This did not stop the development activities of this Multifunctional TFT display. More functionalities were added to the software, while additional hardware items and changes were made as well. Years of accumulated know-how in indication technology and valuable customer feedback can be found in the OMC-140.

Choosing your indicator and hardware

In 'the old days' each application required a different indicator. In this new era, Observator just has two types in her portfolio:

- OMC-140
Multifunctional TFT Display suitable for 90..240 Vac
- OMC-140-24
Multifunctional TFT Display suitable for 24 Vdc

The two serial RS422 NMEA inputs, together with the LAN port, are in most cases sufficient to have a suitable display for each application. For met-systems, we do advice our MeteoLink solution, which comes with one combined NMEA output for a basic parameter, such as wind speed and direction, temperature, humidity, dew point, baro pressure (QFE and QNH), solar radiation. Obviously, cloud base, as well as visibility and present weather, and other crucial parameters can be added to MeteoLink.

The OMC-140 is provided with comprehensive alarm handling possibilities. In case these alarms should be available for external devices, such as horns and warning lights, the OMC-140-02 may be applied. This unit comes with two relay outputs, which can be set as n/o or n/c. This is a commonly used module in MESCAQ configurations on board tankers and installed in the CCR. A SD Card, which may be ordered as OMC-140-53, may be placed into the display and offers the possibility to log all measurements, something which is required within MESCAQ as well.



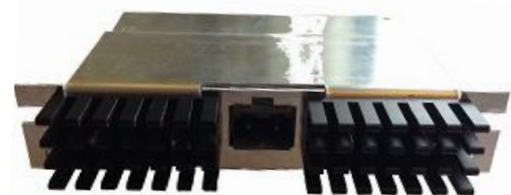
OMC-140-02 remote control & relay output module

This same unit is required to connect a remote-control panel, which can be used for dimming and other basic functions, in case the display is harder to reach.

A third extension module is available, making it possible to use the display in an AC power-configuration, with auto switch to a DC power back-up. The same module can be used in case the only power supply available is 12 DC.



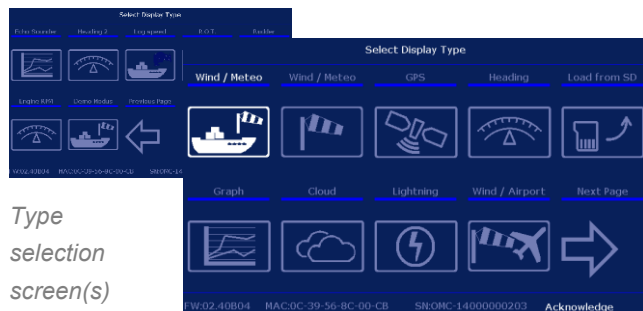
OMC-140-01 12..24 Vdc power supply module

Choosing your display

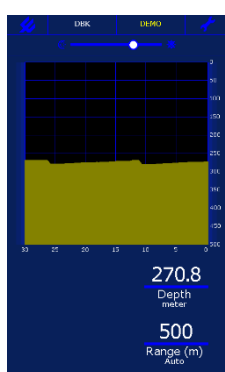
When powering up the OMC-140 the first time, a selection screen appears in which you can choose your typical application:



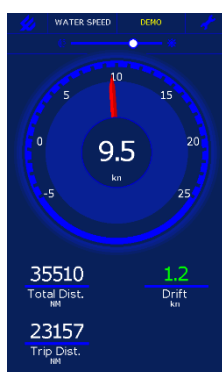
A variety of display types may be selected: standard meteo/wind, meteo/wind for ship applications, meteo/wind airports, graphs, cloud base, lightning, GPS, heading, echo sounder, speed log, R.O.T., rudder, RPM, etc. Furthermore, some customised OEM versions are available (password protected).



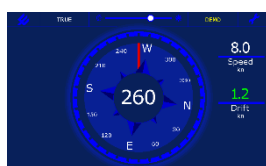
Display for wind/meteo on airfields. Wind information is shown relative to the north, as well as to the runway. Runway heading may be adapted (during installation), while parameters are indicated conform ICAO regulations.

Choosing your parameters

After a display type is selected and the data is gathered, either through one of the serial NMEA inputs or by the LAN connection, a setup of the display can be made. Each offered and known parameter may be positioned on the display, by selecting these in the advanced menu (password protected).

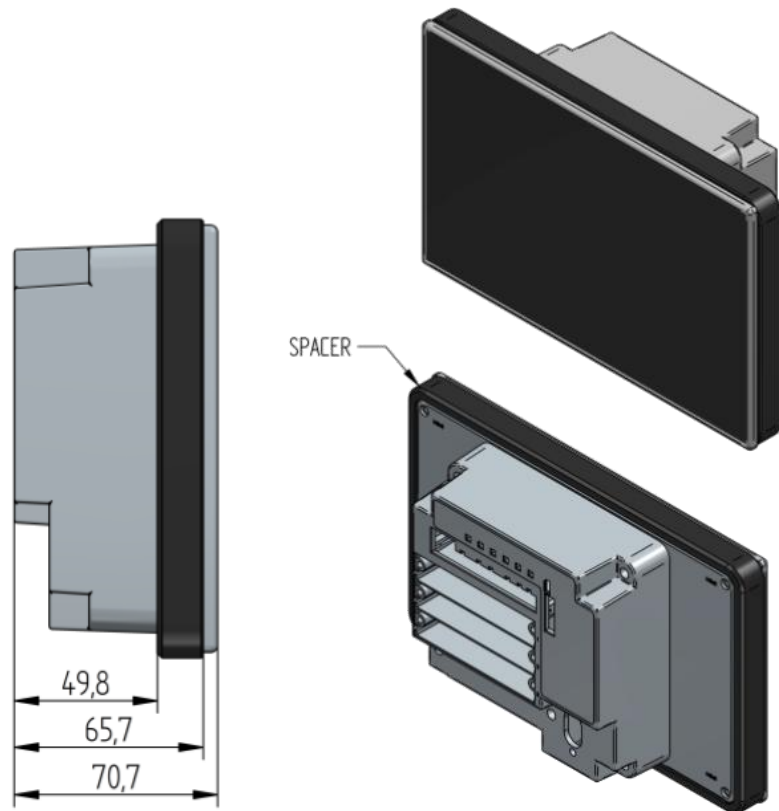
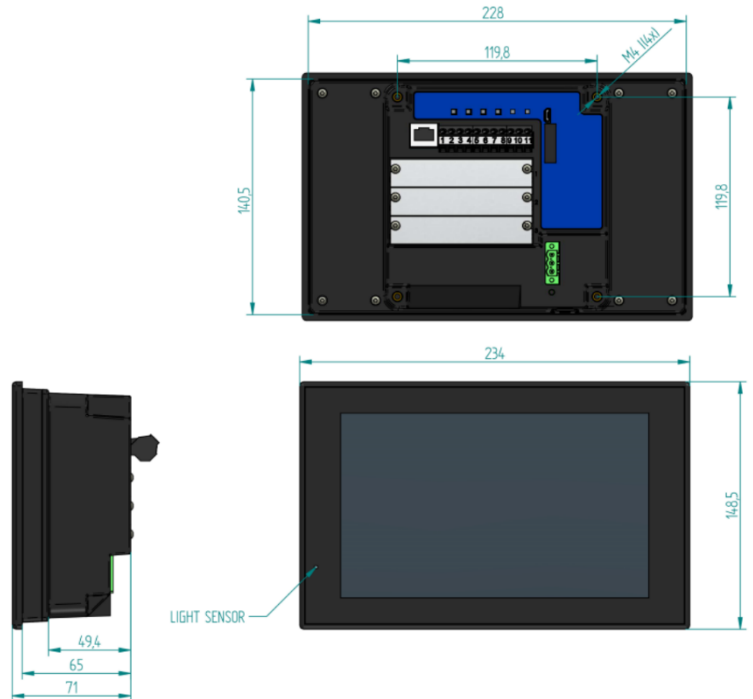
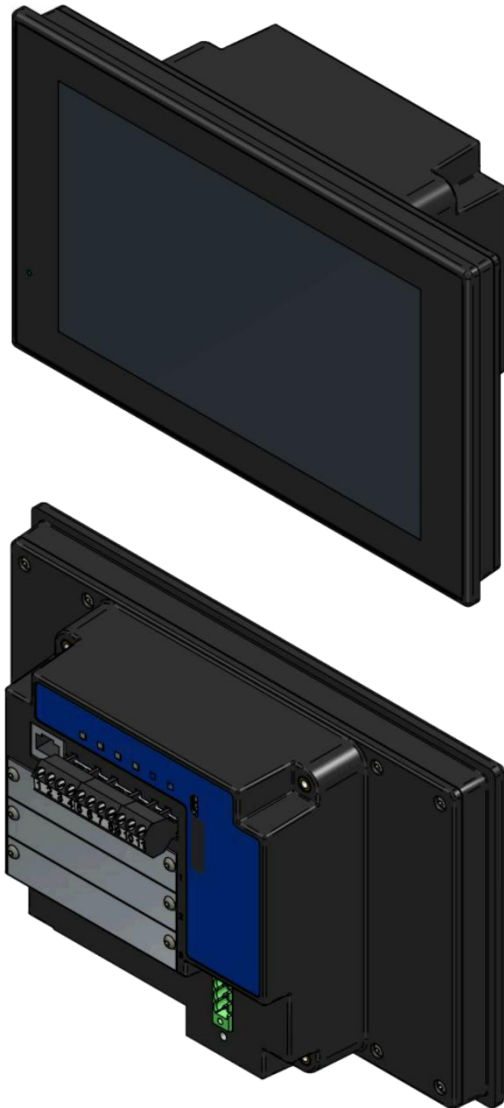
